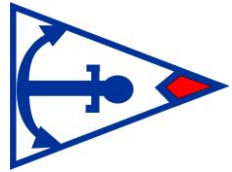

From the Bridge...

Planning is underway for our AGM / Graduation on May 10. In this issue you will find an invitation to the AGM, an agenda for the evening and the Nominating Committee Report with the names of people who are standing for Bridge positions for the upcoming year. We have graduates from the Boating 1 and Boating 2 courses who will receive their memberships and recognition of members who have served the squadron over the past years.

Some of our Bridge members are currently working on the Boating 7 course (Offshore Navigation). This course was offered on-line and taught by P/C/C Tony Gardiner. A lot has changed since the N course was taught even a few years ago. In the current program, computer software plays a big part in planning and tracking offshore voyages. Students in this course have had to become competent with *Visual Passage Planner 2* and *Open CPN* software to complete the practice cruise and the exam.

For most of us April is the month when we get our boats ready for launch. This is a big process involving waxing and polishing the hull, applying a new coat of anti-fouling paint, charging batteries, readying the engine, and checking out all the safety equipment. This is also the time when we need to check the dates on our flares. If you find that they have past their best before date (flares cannot exceed 4 years from the date of manufacture in order to be approved for use by Transport Canada) consider joining us at Krate's Marina on Friday, June 2 when the Squadron and York Region Police will collect and dispose of all your expired marine flares.

We have a special event planned for your entertainment. On May 3, Doug James will describe how he and his family prepared for and enjoyed a charter in the BVIs. This event is part of our toonie night presentations and is open to all members and their guests. See details in this edition of the Bitter End.

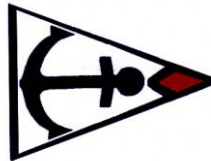

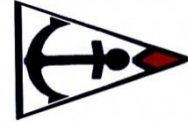

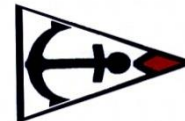
