YOUR PCOC BOATING LICENCE GETS YOU ON THE WATER, LET OUR BOATING SAFETY COURSES HELP GET YOU HOME AGAIN

1. Beyond the PCOC

Enjoyment and safety on the water require knowledge. Beyond the PCOC will take you to the next level in your boating education. This course also has a number of optional topics that will be taught depending on the needs of the students; these include canals and locks, towing, trailering and a check list for layup and launch.

2. Electronic Navigation

This course is practical and hands-on and will review your knowledge of chart reading, conning, traditional chart plotting and the Global Positioning System. You will be introduced into the use of a GPS and Chart plotter as a navigating tool using Way Points and Electronic Chart plotting. You'll come away with an understanding of how a GPS and Chart plotter works, both theoretically and practically. This will assist you to navigate safely knowing your exact location at all times. The Course includes a CD containing a number of charts and a full scale simulator of a chart plotter to help you learn by doing. Join with others to share experiences. If you're not getting the most out of your GPS, we'll update your skills and help you transition from paper to pixels.

3. Restricted Marine Radio Operator's Certificate (Marine Radio)




Second Annual Evening of "Just Desserts"
