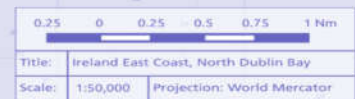

Safety Recall of Kidde Fire Extinguishers

Recall notice as seen on Canadian Yachting website:

Please be advised that 134 models of Kidde fire extinguishers have been recalled.

Extinguishers manufactured from January 1, 1973 and August 15, 2017 and have a 10 digit model number on the label which confirms the date of manufacture. You will need that number to determine with Kidde representatives if you are entitled to a replacement extinguisher.

Please check your boats and homes to see if you have any Kidde fire extinguishers.

The Captain's Table

PORK - BAKED STUFFED TENDERLOIN



Instead of turkey, why not try a stuffed pork tenderloin?

Ingredients and instructions are given below however, I do not use the chili peppers when I make this up and to make it more festive, I serve this with cranberry sauce.

Ingredients:

1 (2 to 2 1/2 lb.) pork tenderloin (8 to 9-inches)
 1 can chili peppers, chopped fine
 5 green onions, chopped fine
 1 dash salt and pepper to taste
 1 dash garlic powder to taste
 2 c. herb seasoned stuffing mix
 1 cube bouillon (use beef if pork not available)
 1/2 c. hot water (to dissolve cube)
 1/2 lb. bacon (for wrapping tenderloin)

Instructions:

Preheat oven to 325°F.

Dissolve bouillon cube in 1/2 cup hot water. Split tenderloin lengthways; do not cut all the way through. Set aside. Mix all other ingredients together well. Stuff tenderloin with mixture.

Wrap stuffed tenderloin with strips of bacon, securing ends with toothpicks. Place in baking dish. Cover tightly with foil. Bake at 325°F for 1-1/2 hours (I did broil at the end so bacon became crispier) or place on hot grill and grill for 30 to 40 minutes. Slice crossways. Serve hot with your favorite gravy, "as is" or try either apple or cranberry sauce!

Makes 6 servings.

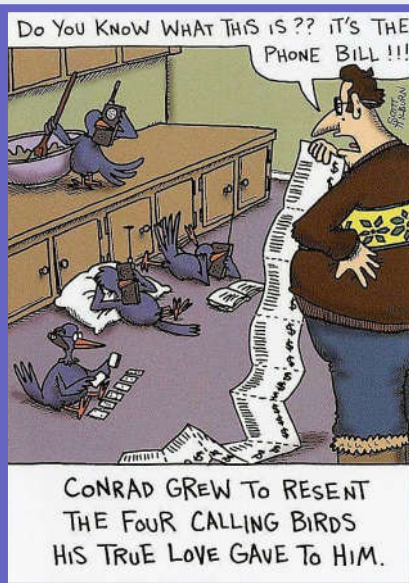
