

## Register and be safe for the 2018 Boating Season!

VHF: Tuesday, March 6th, 2018 from 7-10pm at Willy's Galley with Lynn Meisl.

Cost is \$110 This course is designed with a Home Study component and In Class Training. Once you register a Textbook will be delivered to your home. You must read the book thoroughly and memorize the phonetic alphabet. On the night of the course you will be presented with additional information, hands on radio calls, clarification of protocols and rules and etiquette.

PCOC (aka Boating I): Tuesday, April 10th, 2018 from 7-10pm at Willy's Galley with Lynn Meisl Cost is \$100 Get your Pleasure Craft Operator Card! All operators of motorized pleasure craft are required to show proof of operator competency. All you need to know for the Transport Canada test is presented in an easy to read format that is both informative and entertaining. You can be confident that this study guide meets all the standards established by Transport Canada's Office of Boating Safety. This course has a home study and in-class component. Once registered you will receive a PCOC book in the mail. This book needs to be thoroughly studied before the class date. In class, all subjects will be clarified and expanded on.

## The Captain's Table

## Chicken Fajitas in Foil Packets



#### Ingredients:

- 4 boneless chicken breast
- 3-4 tbsp. taco seasoning mix
- I red onion, thinly sliced
- I of each, red, yellow and orange peppers, thinly sliced
- I tsp smoked paprika (optional)
- I lime
- 3 tsp extra virgin olive oil
- 2 avocados
- 2 cups cherry tomatoes (I dice regular tomatoes)
- I cup sour cream (or Greek yogurt if you prefer!)
- 1/4 cup cilantro
- Tortillas or tortilla chips

#### Instructions:

- -Cut four squares of heavy-duty aluminum foil, about 16 inches square.
- -Lay out on your counter and top each with a 16-inch square of parchment paper (optional)
- -Slice chicken breasts crosswise into thin strips. Sprinkle each with up to I Tablespoon of taco seasoning mix. Place one breast on each of the foil/parchment paper squares.
- -Divide peppers and onions evenly and arrange beside each of the chicken breasts.
- -Sprinkle the peppers with I/4 teaspoon smoked paprika, if desired. Drizzle the chicken and peppers with I teaspoon olive oil, Squeeze a little lime juice on each.

- -Fold foil loosely over chicken, securing ends, but allowing a little space for heat to circulate. Refrigerate until ready to grill.
- -Grill over medium heat, checking for doneness after 20 minutes.
- -Fill tortillas and garnish with cilantro. Serve with sliced avocados (or homemade guacamole), tomatoes, sour cream. Alternatively, you can serve with tortilla chips.
- ~Serves 4
