Haul Out Checklist

•Check the condition of the cradle	
•Pump out the holding tank	
•Replace engine oil	
•Pump out bilge water	
•Lower mast onto mast crutch	
After Haul Out	
•Remove and clean fenders	
•Scrub down algae on hull	
Clean marks above water line	
Wax and polish the hull and superstructure	
•Remove all items that could rot, rust, freeze, suffer moisture damage	
•Remove VHF and GPS equipment and antennae	
Check items left onboard and list items to be replaced	
•Remove dry-cell batteries from all equipment	
Open all seacocks to drain water	
Drain gunk out of bottom of water seperator	
•Run anti-freeze through engine	
•Replace/clean the air filter	
•Slacken fan belts	
•Store anchors and boat hooks below	
Pump 4 litres of anti-freeze in the holding tank	
Grease both ends of throttle, gear and stop cables	
Disconnect propane tank	
Disconnect and Charge batteries	
•Remove jib sheet blocks from tracks	
•Remove fire extinguishers	
•Pump out bilge	
Pour 4 litres of anti-freeze into bilge & pump through bildge pump	
•Empty the garbage container	
•Pump out the water tank & run anti-freeze through water system	
•Tape over the exhaust pipe and other through-hull openings	
Open lockers and cupboards	
•Empty icebox	
Pour some anti-freeze down the sink	
•Store boom below	
Open up floorboards	
Put anti-freeze in all cockpit drains	
Check standing and running rigging	
Open forward hatch very slightly	
•Insert drop boards into companionway	
•Put winter covers on
