The following courses are currently running or in planning by vour Sauadron (all courses are online until further notice) for

early 2021. In some cases we are combining and coordinating with other squadrons to offer various courses.

Pleasure Craft Operating Certificate (PCOC):

Anytime - you can do it online at <u>www.cps-ecp.ca/</u>. Fee is just under \$50. Sorry, no classroom courses until further notice.

Maritime Radio (Restricted Operator's Certificate):

Self-study courses are available in two formats on a continuous basis (when convenient for you). Currently, two courses are underway and another will start on the 19th of January 2021.

Boating 2 & 3 Combined (Beyond the PCOC & Introduction to Marine Navigation):

Started on the 21st of October and the course is full. There is additional interest so that another may be set up to run in the New Year.

Boating 4 (Near Shore Marine Navigation Level 1):

Planned to start in February 2021.

Boating 7 (Offshore Marine Navigation Level 2):**

Planned for start on the 16th of February. There is still space available for this course.


